5.1 23C313 full application to change the use of the former school into a dwelling , a private garage and stables at Ysgol Ty Mawr , Capel Coch - no comments

5.2 41C125B/EIA/RE (Additional) Full application for the erection of three wind turbines 800kw - 900kw with a maximum hub height of 55m , rotor diameter up to a maximum tip height of 52m and a maximum of 81m vertical , improvements to the existing access road to the A5025 , along with raising 3 storage cabinets for equipment on land at Bryn Eryr Uchaf , Menai Bridge. It was resolved to oppose the application : Applications such as these have nothing to do with the science of climate change . They are engaged in farming subsidy . There are no benefits to the community, only to landowners. The size and scale of this application is far too big . The wind turbines will have a visual impact and noise that will affect wildlife, in the rural landscape , and it will be seen for miles . It will produce very little energy .Wind turbines of this size would ruin the beauty of the Island . They will also affect tourism . In other areas where applications have been approved , tourism has fallen by 25

% . Tourism is the main industry on the island . Wind turbines can contribute to health problems , especially for those living in close proximity . They will reduce the value of properties in the area . Also, the Council felt that 3 turbines makes it a market project. There is a need for community energy such as use water to generate electricity .
